


#### **Outcomes**

## PhD review and improvement

- Our throughput has increased by 18% since 2020.
- We have limited our input from 450 postgraduate students to 250 due to workload.
- Extraordinary researchers welcome to do co supervision- principle of don't set postgraduate students up for failure.
- Importance of students adhering to targets of study periods (target, target plus one...).
- Faculty Board on language editing by language practitioner.
- International students: SAQA and proficiency in English.



#### Research Focus Area Ancient Texts

#### Strategy

The core strategy of the Research Focus Area Ancient Texts is to <u>improve research productivity</u> and to <u>broaden participation</u> by investing in <u>staff development</u> that aligns with their <u>strengths</u> and interests in order to produce <u>high-quality research</u> on <u>current issues</u> in the field of ancient texts. To achieve this, there should be a more <u>focused approach</u>, more even <u>workload</u> <u>distribution</u>, and <u>interdisciplinary</u> <u>collaboration</u>.

Expanding the <u>international</u> footprint can be done by creating tangible MOUs and <u>collaborating</u> with researchers in related fields to bring in <u>new perspectives</u> and <u>funding</u> sources.

An increase in the number of **postgraduate students** will be essential to contribute to **sustainability** in the long term.
